Description of Neuropsychology Postdoctoral Fellowship

Hackensack University Medical Center (HUMC) at Hackensack Meridian Health announces an opening for a two year, full-time postdoctoral fellowship in clinical neuropsychology within the HUMC Neuroscience Institute/Department of Neurology. Hackensack Meridian Health is an Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action employer and training site.

Program Description:

The fellow will conduct all aspects of outpatient neuropsychological evaluation of adults with a variety of neurological conditions, including neurodegenerative diseases, demyelinating conditions, movement disorders, cerebrovascular disease, epilepsy, brain tumors, brain injury, concussion, and co-morbid mood/adjustment disorders. The fellow will also have an occasional opportunity to conduct evaluations of children and adolescents with a variety of neurological and neuropsychiatric diagnoses. The fellow will spend approximately 10% of the time engaging in clinical research projects. They will have opportunities to present and disseminate data from these projects at professional conferences and in peer-reviewed publications.

The Neuroscience Institute at HUMC is located in the heart of a diverse community, serving patients from a wide variety of cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds. In addition to expanding their competencies with regard to neuropsychological evaluation, our trainees will be prepared for serving in supervisory roles. The trainee will be working with a superb team of neurologists, neuropsychologists, geriatricians, health psychologists, and a licensed clinical social worker specializing in geriatric population.

Didactics include seminars covering a variety of topics including case studies and fact finding, common and rare neurological syndromes encountered in neuropsychology practice, neurology and psychiatry grand rounds, ethical considerations, professional development, and ABPP-CN exam preparation. Additionally, the fellow will have access to many other didactic opportunities to participate in rounds and presentations offered by other departments at the Hackensack Meridian Health.

Eligibility:

Candidates must have completed all doctoral degree requirements including one-year internship training in clinical neuropsychology or related discipline and be eligible for a limited permit to practice psychology in New Jersey prior to start date. Candidates aspiring to ABCN board certification and those who are board-eligible are preferred.
