

The externship program is designed for doctoral students in psychology who are interested in developing their clinical skills in neuropsychological assessment and building their knowledge of brain-behavior relationships. This externship is offered through the Department of Rehabilitation Medicine at Staten Island University Hospital, which provides services to infants through a geriatric population. It is an ideal setting for externs to gain experience working with a wide variety of presenting concerns across the lifespan and a broad range of psychological, neuropsychological and neurological diagnoses. The externship offers three distinct tracks: Outpatient Neuropsychology, Inpatient Rehabilitation and Brain Injury, and Health Psychology at Cardiac/Pulmonary Rehabilitation program.
