### SENIOR NEUROPSYCHOLOGIST- INPATIENT REHABILITATION

Northwell Staten Island University Hospital is seeking a full-time Neuropsychologist. The neuropsychologist will provide inpatient services to adult patients with acquired brain injuries and other neuromedical conditions, with a particular emphasis on cerebrovascular disease. The neuropsychologist should have training in the provision of assessment and intervention in a medical center/hospital or interdisciplinary rehabilitation treatment team setting. The neuropsychologist will be an integral part of the interdisciplinary rehabilitation team, which includes physicians, nursing, case management, as well as physical, speech, and occupational therapists. The primary patient populations include stroke and acute acquired brain injury, secondary populations are patients with complex medical conditions and dementia.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

Collaborates with the medical, nursing and therapy staff to ensure implementation and coordination of daily clinical and administrative services for individual patients and the unit.  
Keeps abreast of current research literature and trends.

Coordinate and lead weekly multidisciplinary team conferences and Neuropsychology rounds.

Coordinate and lead family meetings.

Coordinate and integrate Neuropsychology principles across all disciplines. Provide ongoing education to rehab and nursing staff in the basic and applied principles of Neuropsychology as they relate to brain injury and treatment.

Provide clinical supervision to psychologists, psychology students and counseling staff. Provide ongoing assessment of program quality reviews and chart reviews. Recommends enhancements to assessment and documentation process.
