Study Hall is offering four Clinical Child Neuropsychology Externship positions for the 2023-24 academic year under the supervision of Katie Davis, Psy.D. The mission of Study Hall is to provide specialized support to individuals who struggle with learning and attention disorders and related developmental disorders. Externs are expected to work two days per week. Hours are flexible but will require after school and evening availability.

Responsibilities will include:

- Individual neuropsychologically-informed psychotherapy and academic remediation
- Consulting with therapists, teachers, and parents
- Psychoeducational and neuropsychological testing

Trainees will develop skills in:

- Therapy
- Remediation
- Parent and school consultation
- Conducting and interpreting neuropsychological evaluations
- Advocacy

This is a paid training opportunity and competitive hourly pay will be offered. Individual and group supervision will be offered. No prior experience is required, and first- and second-year students are welcome to apply.
