Our training program includes a full-time, two-year postdoctoral fellowship, as well as internship and externship opportunities.

Primary Activities

- Individual treatment providing a mix of cognitive remediation, psychotherapy, and tutoring
- Cognitive-behavioral treatments for anxiety and mood disorders
- Neuropsychological and psychoeducational evaluations
- School consultation
- Family consultation
- School-based individual and group psychotherapy

Clinical supervision (Individual)

Clinical supervision (Group)

Neuropsychological assessment supervision (Group)

- Case presentations
- Direct instruction on assessment and case conceptualization

Didactics

- Weekly Neurobiology Seminar: study current neuroimaging research relevant to child development and school function
