



EXTERNSHIP IN CLINICAL NEUROPSYCHOLOGY

The Columbia Comprehensive Epilepsy Center has openings for clinical neuropsychology externs for 2021-2022. Externs will learn to administer, score, and interpret neuropsychological test batteries in patients undergoing evaluation for epilepsy, movement disorders, brain tumors, and other neurological conditions. The patient population includes young children through older adulthood. Externs will have the opportunity to attend surgical case conferences, teaching rounds, and lectures in the Department of Neurology at Columbia University Medical Center. Externs will also have the opportunity to observe intracarotid methohexital testings (Wada Procedure) and intracranial cortical language mappings.

Supervision will be conducted by Drs. Marla Hamberger and Jeffrey Cole.

Current enrollment as a doctoral student in Psychology is required. Graduate coursework in neuropsychology and prior testing experience is strongly preferred.
