



The Mount Sinai Epilepsy Program offers a one-year [July - June], 16-hour per week externship in clinical neuropsychology. Externs will be trained in administering, scoring, and interpreting neuropsychological tests batteries, and writing up integrated neuropsychological reports with patient-specific recommendations. Patients are typically undergoing pre-surgical evaluations for epilepsy, although externs will have the opportunity to see individuals with a variety of referral questions and neurological disorders. Patients seen are mostly adults, with opportunities to work with pediatric patients as well. Externs will be able to observe Wada procedures and intra- and extra-operative language mappings. In addition to weekly individual supervision (2+ hours) and didactics (1 hour), externs can observe multidisciplinary surgical planning conferences.

Applicants must be currently enrolled as a doctoral student in psychology. Graduate coursework in neuropsychology and prior testing experience is preferred.
